Notice of the Passing of an Amendment to Education Development Charges By-law No. 3 (2004) of the Halton Catholic District School Board

TAKE NOTICE that on the 21st day of June, 2005, the Halton Catholic District School Board (the “School Board”) passed Education Development Charge Amending By-law (2005) which amends Education Development Charge By-law No. 3 (2004).

AND TAKE NOTICE that any person or organization may appeal the said amending by-law to the Ontario Municipal Board under section 257.74 of the *Education Act* by filing with the Secretary of the School Board on or before the 31st day of July, 2005, a notice of appeal setting out the objection to the amending by-law and the reasons supporting the objection. The appeal may not raise an issue that could have been raised in an appeal under Section 257.65 of the *Education Act* of Education Development Charges By-law No. 3 (2004).

The said amending by-law comes into force on June 24, 2005. The said amending by-law increases the charge on residential development to \$659.00 per dwelling unit and the charge on non-residential development to \$0.18 per square foot (\$1.93 per square metre) of gross floor area. No other amendment to Education Development Charges By-law No. 3 (2004) has been made in the amending by-law.
